## This is our Calling:

Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; Philippians 2:12.

For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little: Isaiah 28:10.

Keep watch over yourselves and the entire flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. **Be shepherds** of the **church of God**, which He purchased with His own blood. I know that after my departure, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock. Even from your own number, men will rise up and **distort the truth** to draw away disciples after them. Acts 20:28-31.

Let the prophet who has a **dream** retell it, **but let him who has** <u>**My word**</u> speak it truthfully. For what is <u>straw compared to grain?</u> declares the LORD.

For the time will come when men will not tolerate sound doctrine, but with itching ears they will gather around themselves teachers to suit their own desires. So they will turn their ears <u>away from the truth</u> and turn aside **to myths.** 2 Timothy 4:3-4. (1 Samuel 15:26) (Isaiah 30:10)

"In those days, and in that time....My people have been lost sheep. **Their shepherds have led them astray;** They have turned them away on the mountains. They have gone from mountain to hill; They have forgotten their resting place." Jeremiah 50:4,6.

**Thus saith the Lord GOD;** Behold, I am against the shepherds; and I will require my flock at their hand, and cause them to cease from feeding the flock; neither shall the shepherds feed themselves any more; for I will deliver my flock from their mouth, that they may not be meat for them. Ezekiel 34:10... cf. V. 13.

His **watchmen** are blind: they are all ignorant, they are all **dumb** dogs, they **cannot bark**; sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber. Yea, they are greedy dogs which can never have enough, and they are **shepherds that cannot understand**: they all look to their own way, every one for his gain, from his quarter. Isaiah 56:10-11.)

While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. Matthew 25:5.

And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and sealed **till the time of the end.** Daniel 12:9.

Then I heard another voice from heaven saying, "Come out of her, my people, lest you take part in her sins, lest you share in her plagues; Revelation 18:4.

'And some of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify them, and make them white, **until the time of the end**; because it is still for the appointed time.' Daniel 11:35.

The voice of them that **flee and escape** out of the land of Babylon, [US., UK. etc.] **to declare in Zion** the vengeance of the LORD our God, the vengeance of his temple. Jeremiah 50:28.

Ye that have escaped the sword, go away, stand not still: remember the LORD afar off, and **let Jerusalem come into your mind.** Jeremiah 51:50.

For there shall be a day, that *the watchmen upon the mount Ephraim* shall cry, Arise ye, and **let us go up to Zion** unto the LORD our God. **For thus saith the LORD;** Sing with gladness for Jacob, and shout [broadcast] among the chief of the nations: publish ye, praise ye, and say, O LORD, **save thy people, the** *remnant* **of Israel.** Behold, I will [future] bring them..... Jeremiah 31:6-7....

The days of punishment are **coming**, the days of reckoning are at hand. Let Israel know this. Because your sins are so many and your hostility so great, the prophet is considered a fool, the inspired person a maniac. The prophet, along with my God, *is the watchman over Ephraim*, yet snares await him on all his paths, and hostility in the house of his God. Hosea 9:7-8.

Awake, awake, clothe yourself with strength, O Zion! [COG] Put on your garments of splendour, [God's Words] O Jerusalem, holy city! .... Isaiah 52:1....

Cry yet, saying, **Thus saith the LORD of hosts**; My cities through prosperity **shall** yet be spread abroad; and the LORD **shall yet** comfort Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem. Zechariah 1:17.

**Comfort ye, comfort ye my people,** saith your God....The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God....*You who bring good news to Zion,* go up on a high mountain. You who bring good news to Jerusalem, lift up your voice with a shout, [broadcast] lift it up, do not be afraid; say to the towns of Judah, "Here is your God!" Isaiah 40:1, 3, 9. NIV.

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those **who bring good news**, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who **proclaim salvation**, **who say to Zion**, "Your God reigns!" Listen! Your <u>watchmen</u> lift up their voices, [broadcast] together they shout for joy. For every eye <u>will</u> [future] see **when** the LORD returns to Zion... Isaiah 52:7-8.

Behold, the Lord GOD comes with might,
and His arm establishes His rule.
His reward is with Him,
and His recompense accompanies Him.
He tends His flock like a shepherd;
He gathers the lambs in His arms [All actually future tense, *will, will, will.*]
and carries them close to His heart.
He gently leads the nursing ewes. Isaiah 40:10-11.

**<u>I appointed watchmen</u> over you** and said, 'Listen to the sound of the trumpet!' But you said, 'We will not listen.' Jeremiah 6:17.

That this is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will not hear the law of the lord. Isaiah 30:9.

**...because they did not receive the love of the truth,** that they might be saved. And for this reason **God will send them strong delusion,** that they should believe the lie. 2 Thessalonians 2:10-11.

I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace day nor night: ye that make mention of the LORD, keep not silence, And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth. Isaiah 62:6,11.

And that servant, which knew his lord's will, **and prepared not himself, neither did according to his will**, shall be beaten with many stripes. Luke 12:47.

"Then at **the time of the end**, the king of the south will attack the king of the north. The king of the north will storm out with chariots, charioteers, and a vast navy. **He will invade various lands** and sweep through them like a flood. **He will enter** the glorious **land of Israel**, and many nations will fall, but Moab, Edom, and the best part of Ammon will escape. NLT. Daniel 11:40-41. **Then** *let them* **which be in Judaea** ["Comfort ye, comfort ye my people, saith your God"] flee into the mountains: [of Jordan] Matthew 24:16. Fear not, **little flock;** for it is your Father's good pleasure **to give you** the kingdom. Luke 12:32.

And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent. And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood. And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth. And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the <u>remnant</u> of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ. Rev. 12:14-17.

And the LORD shall be seen *over them*, and his arrow shall go forth as the lightning: and the Lord GOD shall blow the trumpet, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south....And the LORD their God shall save them in that day as the flock of his people: for they shall be as the stones of a crown, lifted up as an ensign upon his land. Zechariah 9:14, 16.

Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy. Matthew 22:8.

Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the **children of disobedience.** Ephesians 5:6.

The only Church group mentioned in the Bible at the End-Time are those who **obey** God's Command to comfort His People in their captivity from Jerusalem, from where, as we saw, they will flee at the arrival of the Beast and are rescued by God at the First Resurrection.
