


# The Real Reason for Climate Change

Nevertheless we have to recognise that nations around the world are experiencing increasingly dangerous and damaging weather. Droughts, cyclones, typhoons, tornadoes, extreme cold and heat, floods and storms of all kinds seem to be on the increase, and some of us have already experienced some of these. Older members of society can look back over their lives and see that these symptoms are more common today than in days gone by, so just what could be causing them?

Those of us who live in the Western nations of the world and by that I mean the nations descending from the patriarch Abraham, ( Listen to our audio message 'Britain's Awesome Future') have been

greatly blessed with prosperity, Genesis 12:1-3, 'Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get you out of your country, and from your kindred, and from your father's house, unto a land that I will show you: And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing: And I will bless them that bless you, and curse him that curses you: and in you shall all families of the earth be blessed.' Our nations have seen great population growth. Genesis 13:15-16, 'For all the land which you see, to you will I give it, and to your descendants forever. And I will make your descendants as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall your descendants also be numbered.' And 17:4-7, 'As for me, behold, my covenant is with you, and you shall be a father of many nations. Neither shall your name any more be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made you. And I will make you exceedingly fruitful, and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come out of you. And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your descendants after you in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto you, and to your descendants after you.'

The promises passed down from Isaac, son of Abraham, to his son Jacob, Genesis 27:26-29, 'And his father Isaac said unto him, Come near now, and kiss me, my son. And he came near, and kissed him: and he smelled the smell of his clothing, and blessed him, and said, See, the smell of my son is as the smell of a field which the LORD has blessed: Therefore God give you of the dew of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of grain and wine: Let people serve you, and nations bow down to you: be lord over your brethren, and let your mother's sons bow down to you: cursed be everyone that curses you, and blessed be he that blesses you.'

Truly we have seen our nations feed the needy of the world with our abundant corn, wheat and cattle, and here in Australia we are part of the Commonwealth of nations which was prophesied thousands of years ago – Genesis 35:11-12, 'And God said unto him, I am God Almighty: be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall be of you, and kings shall spring forth from you; And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to you I will give it, and to your descendants after you will I give the land.'

All of these blessings came about because of the obedience of one man, Abraham, who kept God's Commandments (Genesis 26:5, 'Because Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.'). And most of them eventually ended up being descended through Jacob's (Israel's – for God renamed Jacob 'Israel') two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, Genesis 48:14-16, 'And Israel stretched out his right hand, and laid it upon Ephraim's head, who was the younger, and his left hand upon Manasseh's head, guiding his hands knowingly; for Manasseh was the firstborn. And he blessed Joseph, and said, God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac did walk, the God who fed me all my life long unto this day, The Angel who redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; and let my name be perpetuated in them, and the name of my father's Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.'

Manasseh would become great, but Ephraim even greater, Genesis 48:17-19, 'And when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand upon the head of Ephraim, it displeased him: and he held up his father's hand, to remove it from Ephraim's head unto Manasseh's head. And Joseph said unto his father, Not so, my father: for this is the firstborn; put your right hand upon his head. And his father refused, and said, I know it, my son, I know it: he also shall become a people, and he also shall be

great: but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his descendants shall become a multitude of nations.’

Great Britain did indeed found a company of nations, through her vast Empire, and after her decline, America took over as the dominant leader of the world. Together these nations share a common language, heritage and culture and have projected their influence and power worldwide. The Biblical prophecies came true and Ephraim and Manasseh had become the biggest, richest and most powerful nations in the world.

God had chosen them as a people to carry His way of life to the nations, Deuteronomy 26:18-19, ‘And the LORD has declared you this day to be his peculiar people, as he has promised you, and that you should keep all his commandments; And to make you high above all nations which he has made, in praise, and in name, and in honour; and that you may be a holy people unto the LORD your God, as he has spoken.’ They were to be His example of the way that results in prosperity and all things good and would be exalted above all nations if they would obey, Deuteronomy 28:1-2, ‘And it shall come to pass, if you shall hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD your God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command you this day, that the LORD your God will set you on high above all nations of the earth: And all these blessings shall come on you, and overtake you, if you shall hearken unto the voice of the LORD your God.’

For a time they did, and before they split apart, Britain expanded into the greatest Empire this world has ever seen, rich in all the wealth this earth provides, Deuteronomy 32:13 and 33:29, ‘He made him ride on the high places of the earth, that he might eat the increase of the fields; and he made him to suck honey out of the rock, and oil out of the flinty rock.’ .... ‘ Happy are you, O Israel: who is like unto you, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of your help, and who is the sword of your excellency! and your enemies shall submit unto you; and you shall tread upon their high places.’ We here in Australia are still enjoying these blessings today, but we see a gradual change.

Around the world, Britain, America and the great Commonwealth countries founded by Britain – Canada, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa are all encountering difficulty, and climate change is but one of the problems we face. The real cause of all these problems is made clear in just one chapter of the Bible.

That chapter is Deuteronomy 28. There, God tells us that we should be the example to the world, verse 9 – ‘The LORD shall establish you a holy people unto himself, as he has sworn unto you, if you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and walk in his ways.’ For a time we were, carrying the civilising influence of the Bible into the far reaches of the Empire. Admittedly it was not done perfectly, but no men are perfect. The result, through God’s mercy, was verses 11-13, ‘And the LORD shall make you bountiful in goods, in the fruit of your body, and in the fruit of your cattle, and in the fruit of your ground, in the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers to give you. The LORD shall open unto you his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand: and you shall lend unto many nations, and you shall not borrow. And the LORD shall make you the head, and not the tail; and you shall be above only, and you shall not be beneath; if that you hearken unto the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day, to observe and to do them.’

But, as time went by, one man, Charles Darwin, with his theory of evolution, introduced the most effective and destructive idea Satan ever came up with. Now today, that theory is seen as failing to provide the answers for the ever deeper and more awesome complexity of the genetic makeup of life, but it has had the effect for many of undermining their faith and belief in the Creator God.

Thousands, in just a few generations, have turned away from their faith. Churches dwindled and closed. The Bible generally ceased to be opened, and across the world Israel led the way in turning to materialism, atheism and even false religions. The ‘swinging sixties’ brought free love, abortions and the rejection of many of the laws which were based directly on the Commandments of the Bible. Political correctness began to change Right into Wrong, and Wrong into Right, so that soon Christianity itself came under attack, and in some nations to speak out against what the Bible calls an abomination, homosexuality, risked breaking new laws. God became justifiably angry. Isaiah 5:20-21, ‘Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight!’

God gave one of His prophets a message for us. Ezekiel 2:3-5, ‘And he said unto me, Son of man, I send you to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that has rebelled against me: they and their fathers have transgressed against me, even unto this very day. For they are impudent children and stubborn. I do send you unto them; and you shall say unto them, Thus says the Lord GOD. And they, whether they will hear, or whether they refuse, (for they are a rebellious house,) yet shall know that there has been a prophet among them.’ He knew that very few would take note, verse 7, ‘And you shall speak my words unto them, whether they will hear, or whether they refuse: for they are most rebellious.’ (Listen to our audio message “Choose Your Future”, on Media tab. )

So it was that He began to take away the blessings of Deuteronomy 28:1-14, and replace them with the curses of the rest of the chapter, and what we are seeing today in damaging climate change is just a small part of what we have earned by our arrogant rejection of His Laws and way of life, verses 16, 23-24, 38, and 40 –

16 ‘Cursed shall you be in the city, and cursed shall you be in the field.

23-24 And your heaven that is over your head shall be bronze, and the earth that is under you shall be iron. The LORD shall make the rain of your land powder and dust: from heaven shall it come down upon you, until you be destroyed.

38 You shall carry much seed out into the field, and shall gather but little in; for the locust shall consume it.

40 You shall have olive trees throughout all your borders, but you shall not anoint yourself with the oil; for your olives shall drop off.’

The whole chapter makes difficult reading, but these things will come upon us, if we do not repent. Israel was to be God’s example to the world, but our choices have made us detestable in His sight, Ezekiel 5:11-12, ‘Therefore, as I live, says the Lord GOD; Surely, because you have defiled my sanctuary with all your detestable things, and with all your abominations, therefore will I also diminish you; neither shall my eye spare, neither will I have any pity. A third part of you shall die

with the pestilence, and with famine shall they be consumed in the midst of you: and a third part shall fall by the sword round about you; and I will scatter a third part into all the winds, and I will draw out a sword after them.’

The future is grim indeed if we do not change, and because our Western influence still exists, we have led the world into error, but, thankfully some of the nations we taught God’s way have not departed as far from it as we have, and may well be spared some of the punishment we will receive.

Even within the Western nations of Israel are those few who have not departed from their God and His way, and still keep His commandments to avoid sin. If they stay close enough to His words, they will know what God requires of them when His final warning miraculously reaches all men and women worldwide!

Wherever true Christians are found, God is able to protect His people during the coming troubles. Those in the nations of Israel who can, have a special role to play during the first 3 ½ years of the coming Tribulation, in Jerusalem, but whether they are Israelite or Gentile, some will give their lives as a witness during the persecution of the Fifth Seal (Revelation 6).

Those faithful Christians will take part in the resurrection at the Sixth Seal, just a few months later, the 3 ½ year point in the last 7 years, before the ‘Great Tribulation’ comes upon the earth.

We are told that, after those 7 years of tribulation are completed, there will be few left alive, Isaiah 24:5-6, ‘The earth also is defiled under its inhabitants; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant. Therefore has the curse devoured the earth, and they that dwell in it are desolate: therefore the inhabitants of the earth are burned, and **few men left.**’

Yes, we can expect **even greater temperatures**. ‘*And the fourth angel poured out his bowl upon the sun; and power was given unto it to scorch men with fire.*’ *And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, who has power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.* Revelation 16:8-9.

Nevertheless, of those physical Israelites who survive the troubles ahead, including scorching heat, God will again build Israel, and this time they will not depart from their God, and *will* become that example He desires – Jeremiah 33:24-26, ‘**Consider you not** what this people have spoken, saying, The two families which the LORD has chosen, he has even cast them off? Thus they have despised my people, as if they should be no more a nation before them. Thus says the LORD; If my covenant is not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth; Then will I cast away the descendants of Jacob, and David my servant, so that I will not take any of his descendants to be rulers over the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: **for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them.**’ And Isaiah 66:19. ‘And I will set a sign among them, and I will send those of them that escape unto the nations, to Tarshish, Pul, and Lud, that draw the bow, to Tubal, and Javan, to the coastlands afar off, that have not heard my fame, neither have seen my glory; and they shall declare my glory among the Gentiles.’

All of this will take place in a world restored to Garden of Eden conditions, and global warming will no longer be an issue, when, in the Kingdom of God, mankind at last learns to live the way of life

taught by Jesus Christ. Isaiah 30:23-25, *'Then shall he give the rain for your seed, that you shall sow the ground with; and bread of the increase of the earth, and it shall be rich and plentiful: in that day shall your cattle feed in large pastures. The oxen likewise and the young donkeys that work the ground shall eat savoury provender, which has been winnowed with the shovel and with the fork. And there shall be upon every high mountain, and upon every high hill, rivers and streams of waters in the day of the great slaughter, when the towers fall.'*

.....
