

Feast Dates for 2014

We have two possibilities for those who keep a sighted New Moon from Israel. New Year can be Tuesday, April 1st or Wednesday, April 2nd. On Sunday, March 31 after sunset the crescent will have a visibility factor of 109.1 on Bruce Armstrong's calendar calculations program from Jerusalem. That means it will be seen if conditions are very good such as no Mediterranean haze and such. If that is the case the following dates will be observed. If not the dates would move forward one day except for Wavesheaf day and Pentecost which would stay the same in either April scenario.

All Biblical dates start from sunset of the previous day.

These represent an intercalated 13 month year

First Day of the New Year: Tuesday, April 1 or Wednesday, April 2

Passover: Monday, April 14 or Tuesday, April 15

First Day Unleavened Bread: Tuesday, April 15 or Wednesday, April 16

Wavesheaf Day: Sunday, April 20 - (begins the 50 day count to Pentecost but is not a Feast Day)

Last Day Unleavened Bread: Monday, April 21 or Tuesday, April 22

Pentecost: Sunday, June 8

Festival dates for the 7th month would be as follows. Remember all holy days start from the previous day after sunset.

Trumpets: Saturday, September 27

Atonement: Monday, October 6

Tabernacles: Saturday, October 11 - Friday, October 17

Last Great Day: Saturday, October 18
