The Tribulation - How Long?

Many Bible reading Christians have long believed in a three and a half year tribulation. Some have believed that the church would be taken to a place of safety during those years, at the end of which, those alive in the church would be changed to spirit and rise up to meet with Jesus Christ and the resurrected dead in Christ in the clouds, before returning with Christ to help establish His Kingdom, here on the earth

Daniel the prophet was given a great deal of information about the last days, but he said he did not understand. Daniel 12:8, "I heard but I understood not". A generation has passed since some of us gained our understanding of end-time events. Now God is revealing a deeper understanding of those events through the discovery and keeping of His true calendar which determines the Holy Days Jesus Christ kept, rather than the Hebrew Calendar kept today by the Jews, and this may indeed indicate that we have entered into that last generation (cf. Matthew 24:34, "Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.", Daniel 12:9, 'And he said, "Go your way, Daniel, for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end.').

In Daniel 9:27 we see mentioned a period of time called a week. In the middle of that week, "he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease." Daniel 12:11 shows that from then to the end, the return of Christ to establish His Kingdom, is $3\frac{1}{2}$ years + 30 days. We can work out from this that the whole week must be in the region of seven 7 years.

The last 3½ year period is mentioned many times in the Bible, but a significant point is, that it is preceded by the sealing of some of the servants of God (Revelation 7:3, "saying, "Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads."), by which they are preserved from the opening of the 7th seal, with its 7 trumpet plagues, (Revelation 8) soon after to be poured out upon the earth. Those of us who have already been baptized and received God's Holy Spirit are already sealed,

2 Corinthians 21-22, 'Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, is God: who has also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.'

The church is pictured as a woman in Revelation 12:14, 'But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.' Only a part of God's people are protected by being taken "into her place," for 3½ years. A remnant is left behind who go through the Great Tribulation - Revelation 12:17, 'And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.' Matthew 24:21 "For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.'

If those saints sealed by the time of the 6^{th} Seal, at the middle of the week, are thereby protected somewhere for $3\frac{1}{2}$ years from the plagues of the 7th seal, we can conclude that seals 1-6 must occur before the last $3\frac{1}{2}$ years, and last a roughly equal amount of time, $3\frac{1}{2}$ years, making a total of 7 years for the whole seven seals of the Tribulation!

In Matthew 24, Jesus' disciples asked, 'What shall be the sign of thy coming and the end of the [age]', v3. Jesus then gave them a list of events that would reveal that the end of the age had arrived

and His return was not far off. He went on to say - verses 33-34, "So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you. **This** generation [the one that sees these events take place] shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled."

Did you get that? All these events will take place inside one generation, not over thousands of years! That backs up what we learned from Daniel and Revelation, and now we can examine the first six seals so that we will recognize them when they commence.

The First Six Seals

1st Seal - Revelation 6:2-3

'And I looked, and behold, a white horse. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.....'

Many have understood that this pictures a false Christ and false religion, because He carries a bow, and the Christ we read of in Revelation 19 does not. However, in Habakkuk chapter three we find an End Time picture of Christ returning in victory from Teman (Petra) in Jordan, where He went after Armageddon to rescue some of His people, (read our Article 'Christ Goes to Petra'). Here, His bow is unsheathed, even as His garments are stained with blood, (Isaiah 63:1-40), so this was not a false Christ!

However, though the 1st seal will be the preaching of the true gospel, it will be preached into a world largely deceived by false Christ's and a false gospel as Jesus Christ explained in Matthew 24:4-5. 'And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.'

The true gospel of Jesus Christ returning to rule here on the earth (the gospel of the Kingdom of God) has not yet gone out to all the world. So far we have seen only a false gospel about Jesus Christ published, but this will change, Matthew 24:14 "And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come." It will not be achieved by men!

Luke 21:8 adds that this event takes place when "the time draweth near", ie. in that last generation! That same gospel message is described in Revelation 14:6-7, but here we are also told there that it occurs at "the hour of his judgment", - at the very end of the age! All this tells us that we have yet to see the start of the first seal! 'Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.'

At this miraculous event Christians around the word will rejoice, for their God has triumphed over all others, but as they rejoice and cry 'peace and safety' at last, they neglect to 'Fear God and give glory to Him' – to truly repent. Consequently, when peace and safety are suddenly removed only a few weeks later as Babylon, the world's policeman falls, they are shocked by this arrival of the Day of the Lord, Christ's judgment upon Israel and the world, 1 Thessalonians 5:3, 'For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.'

Then, in severe shock and disappointment, many will fall away from the truth, unlike their faithful

brethren, who did not expect Christ's imminent return, 1 Thessalonians 5:4, 'But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.'

Matthew 24:42, "Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming. Luke 21:34-35, "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly. "For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth."

1 Thessalonians 5:2-3, 'For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night. For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape.'

Matthew 24:37-39, "But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be "For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, "and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be."

2nd Seal Revelation 6:3-4

'When He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come and see." Another horse, fiery red, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that people should kill one another; and there was given to him a great sword.'

This is a great world-wide war, which will soon follow the preaching of the true gospel, during which all the events leading up to Christ's return will be miraculously explained to the world by the first angel of Revelation 14 in dreams and visions. This war is the "wars and rumours of wars," of Matthew 24:6.

This event arrives suddenly and with great impact, Revelation 18:2,8,10,

- 2 'And he cried mightily with a loud voice, saying, "Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become a dwelling place of demons, a prison for every foul spirit, and a cage for every unclean and hated bird!'
- 8 "Therefore her plagues will come in one day—death and mourning and famine. And she will be utterly burned with fire, for strong is the Lord God who judges her.
- 10 "standing at a distance for fear of her torment, saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one hour your judgment has come.'

(Look to our article entitled, 'What is Babylon?' to find out what and where this biblical 'Babylon' is today). This great event will take place quite unexpectedly to most people, an event so enormous that it will trigger "the tribulation of those days", the awesome events of the next 5 seals which see the destruction of one quarter of the world's population!

None of us can escape this part of the tribulation, for it begins to take place some three years before the 6th seal is complete. We can only prepare for it by making sure we are right with God, Psalm 91:3-11,

'Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler And from the perilous pestilence.

4 He shall cover you with His feathers,

And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler.

5 You shall not be afraid of the terror by night,

Nor of the arrow that flies by day,

6 Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness,

Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.

7 A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand;

But it shall not come near you.

8 Only with your eyes shall you look, And see the reward of the wicked.

9 Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge,

Even the Most High, your dwelling place,

10 No evil shall befall you,

Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;

11 For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways.'

Many of God's people have become complacent, thinking that the events of the last $3\frac{1}{2}$ years, starting with those events around Jerusalem (Daniel 12:11), will give them plenty of time to put themselves right with God. But if they are here on the earth to see those events take place, it will be because they have been left behind (Revelation 12:17) after Christ came for His firstfruit harvest at the Sixth Seal, when, because they were expecting to see the events of the last $3\frac{1}{2}$ years first, they were caught totally unprepared. (Matthew 25:1-13).

Many will pay with their lives for their error, in the Great Tribulation, Revelation 3:17-18 "Because you say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing'—and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked — "I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see." They had quenched God's Holy Spirit!

The answer to our title then, is that the tribulation covers the whole 7 seals. The first six seals, (the tribulation of those days - Matthew 24:29), last roughly 3½ years. The Great tribulation, or 7th seal, lasts another 3½ years - 7 years in total.

3rd Seal - Revelation 6:5-6, 'When He opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, "Come and see." So I looked, and behold, a black horse, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine." Famine follows this war as a direct result

4th Seal - Revelation 6:7-8, 'When He opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come and see." So I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the beasts of the earth.' Death quickly follows for ¼ of the world's population from violence, hunger, disease and wild beasts, as civilization breaks down worldwide.

Never have we seen such worldwide tragedy and death on such a huge scale from such a horrifying series of events, but there is more to come!

5th Seal - Revelation 6:9-11, 'When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood

on those who dwell on the earth?" Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.'

Matthew 24:9-10, "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. "And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another."

This worldwide persecution of the saints, takes place at the time of betrayal and apostasy in the church, 2 Thessalonians 2:3, 'Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition,'

6th Seal - Revelation 6:12-17, 'I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood. And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, as a fig tree drops its late figs when it is shaken by a mighty wind. Then the sky receded as a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island was moved out of its place. And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains, and said to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! "For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

Matthew 24:29, "Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. This is immediately followed by the resurrection in verse 31.

Revelation 14:15, 'And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, "Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe." This harvest is the firstfruit harvest, the resurrection of the Saints.

Matthew explains that this event follows "the tribulation of those days," ie. the previous 5 seals, all coming over some 3½ years or so, as the scriptures reveal.

This then, is the return of Christ for the firstfruit harvest of His saints at the 6th Seal. He comes in the clouds and his angels gather the Saints to him at the resurrection (Matthew 24:30-31), while mankind hides in fear from the sight of Christ on His throne (Revelation 6:16), because they remember then the warnings they were given along with the true gospel, about the coming wrath of God upon those who have not repented.

The 7th Seal

Revelation 14:18-19, 'And another angel came out from the altar, who had power over fire, and he cried with a loud cry to him who had the sharp sickle, saying, "Thrust in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe." So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into **the great winepress of the wrath of God**.

Revelation 8:1-2,

'And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour. And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets.'

[The Trumpet Plagues begin The Great Tribulation.] In the 7th Seal, at least one- third of all people are killed, as were one fourth of mankind in 6:7-8. If it were not for Christ's promise, no one would remain alive, Matthew 24:22,

'And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: [alive] but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.'

You now know quite clearly that the 7 seals of the tribulation last 7 years: $3\frac{1}{2}$ years of the 'tribulation of those days', followed by the return of Christ for His firstfruit saints at the 6^{th} seal, and another $3\frac{1}{2}$ years of the Great Tribulation.

You also now know that the tribulation starts with the 1st angel of Revelation 14 bringing those 'dreams and visions' to all the world, so that there will be no mistaking the start of the last seven years! But then, while the 'Christian' world rejoices, you know that the fall of Babylon lies just ahead, as we saw in 1 Thessalonians 5:2,4.

True Christians in the nations of Israel will know that it is not time to rejoice yet, despite the cries of 'peace and safety' around the 'Christian world', for they understand that they should then flee from Babylon before it falls, Revelation 18:4, 'And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.'

Where God says they must go, and what He says they should do, is explained in the End Time Series - (i) 'Come Out Of Her My People'.
